## Upgraded pharmacy services provided by all CPESN Pharmacies

- Compare your hospital discharge prescriptions to all of the medications you have been taking at home to avoid medication errors
- Time your refills so all your medications are ready to be picked up or delivered at the same time
- Provide any vaccines needed throughout the year at your local pharmacy

## Also, all CPESN Pharmacies:

- Offer a private area to talk with you about your medications and related health problems
- Review your medications to determine the best ones for you
- Talk about the benefits and possible side effects of medications
- Help you understand why it's important to take your medications as directed by your doctor, and how to make that easier for you
- Work with your doctor to help answer any questions you have about your medications
